授業の 目的と概要	The course is designed to teach 'non-native-English-speaking' students and researchers basic presentation skills that can be honed, then complimented with other strategies, which can then be adapted as one discovers the skills most beneficial to his or her style of making a public presentation.																														
学習の 到達目標	The course primarily aims to develop and enhance the students oral communication skills in English by engaging them in meaningful interactive activities. Specifically, students will be able to: 1) acquire understanding of the nature and function of language and effective oral communication 2) learn correct pronunciation of critical vowels and consonant sounds 3) recognize and use correct speech patterns: intonation, stress, and strategic pausing 4) speak clearly and spontaneously by adapting one's speech to situation, circumstances, and audience expectations 5) use communication strategies (ex. paraphrase, rewording) to enhance communication
